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BOLOGNA PROCESS IMPLEMENTATION IN THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

- Structure of two cycle system in accordance with Bologna Principles, since 2005 (Bachelor: 240 ECTS, Master: 120 ECTS, Candidate of Sciences (equivalent to PhD): 180 ECTS)
- -> ECTS implementation in all higher education institutions and all programs
- -> Implementation of the Diploma Supplement in all higher education institutions
- -> National Center for Professional Education Quality Assurance (ANQA) established in 2008
- -> Quality Assurance Departments created within each higher education institution
- -> Institutional and programme accreditation
- National Qualifications Framework (NQF) consists of 8 levels
- National Information Center for Academic Recognition and Mobility (ArmENIC) set up as an independent body responsible for mutual recognition of qualifications within the European and international communities.
- "Concept of lifelong learning in the Republic of Armenia" approved by the Government of Armenia




